With the support of grant funding, Tri Arts Project is able to bring the joy of art to senior living communities across Douglas County through a series of free acrylic painting classes. Programs like these provide more than just art education—they foster connection, reduce isolation, and promote mental well-being. Seniors benefit from the therapeutic qualities of creative expression, which can improve cognitive function, reduce stress, and bring a sense of joy and community into their lives.

The overwhelmingly positive feedback highlights the program's impact, particularly for seniors on fixed incomes who might not otherwise have access to such enriching activities. These classes are a testament to the profound role creativity plays in enhancing lives.


