Recommended Ages

At Tri Arts Project, most of our classes are designed for adults, with a general age guideline of 16 and up. However, we also offer select classes specifically for children (ages 5+) and some for adults 18+. Each class description clearly lists its age requirements. 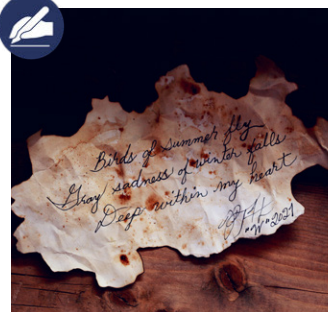


Refund Policy

Students cancelling their registration within 7 days of course start date are not eligible for a refund.

TAP Outreach in the Community

In 2024, TAP was awarded a grant through Douglas County Community Foundation along with an additional donation from Vaughn Law Offices to perform outreach, taking our creative classes to senior living communities across Douglas County through a series of free art classes. Our goal was to create art programs and resources that directly address the unique challenges faced by these individuals, ensuring they have access to creative arts and opportunities for engagement. By prioritizing low-income seniors, we aimed to foster a more inclusive and supportive environment that enriches their quality of life.

Programs like these reduce isolation and promote mental wellness through qualities of creative expression, which can improve cognitive function, reduce stress, and bring a sense of joy and community into their lives. We were able to serve seven different senior centers, and provide the instructor and all supplies at no cost for over 80 students. The overwhelmingly positive feedback highlights the program's impact, who might not otherwise have access to such enriching activities. These classes are a testament to the profound role creativity plays in enhancing lives.

As one participant stated, "Art is therapy for us."
