

Recommended Ages

At Tri Arts Project, most of our classes are designed for adults, with a general age guideline of 16 and up. However, we also offer select classes specifically for children (ages 5+) and some for adults 18+. Each class description clearly lists its age requirements. If you'd like to enroll a child under 16, exceptions can be made on a case-by-case basis—just email us at ASKTap@triartsproject.org to discuss your request!

TAP Connecting the Community

TAP is grateful to be the recipient of grants that make the arts even more accessible to our community. For 2 years in a row, TAP was awarded grants through Douglas County Community Foundation to perform outreach programs, taking our creative classes to senior living communities across Douglas County. Our goal was to create resources that directly address the unique challenges faced by these individuals, ensuring they have access to creative arts and opportunities for engagement. Programs like these reduce isolation and promote mental wellness through creative expression, which can improve cognitive function, reduce stress, bring a sense of joy, and improve quality of life. We have served over seven different senior centers, providing instructors and supplies at no cost for over 100 participants. The overwhelmingly positive feedback highlights the program's impact.


Additionally, TAP was honored to receive two new grants in 2025. The Indigo Oak Fund award helped to facilitate our programming, improve our classroom resources, and reduce costs to participants. 
